ChristmasBox



Many children (and adults!) struggle to make the links between all of the secular Christmas traditions they enjoy every year and the original events of the nativity. ChristmasBox is a way of teaching primary school classes and church based groups how we can see Jesus in every tradition we see around us at this time of year, be it shepherds on a hillside in a woolly Christmas jumper or the King of Kings who calls us to eternal life in our evergreen Christmas tree...



Providing a fun and interactive session lasting for about one hour, the ChristmasBox resources can be delivered directly to your school/church and a teacher/volunteer can deliver the material from a lesson plan or script or using the prerecorded video clips from the Red Balloon Foundation team. Or, new for 2020, our team can even join you by Zoom and facilitate live!

The sessions are structured into four sections which include the annunciation, shepherds, Magi and birth of Jesus, linking those four key elements of the nativity with modern secular Christmas through English, music and sensory activities.

Each ChristmasBox costs RBF £60 to prepare and churches can use them on a 'borrow and return' basis or they can purchase them to use year after year. Like all of the resources that RBF offer, we provide them on a 'pay what you can' basis so some churches will pay £60 a box, some use them for free and others donate more.

There are thirty of each resource that the children need to interact with in each box (with top ups supplied where multiple groups are using the boxes) and everything is easy to clean and sanitise ready for the next group to use, making this a great COVID19 secure way to engage your local schools and ministry groups with the Christmas story! 


Bible Society

Christmas Countdown

Girls' Brigade Ministries has also produced a Christmas Countdown resource – this consists of two programme booklets – one for 4 to 11s and one for 10 to 18s.

Christmas Countdown is a look at the themes of advent – a journey together towards Christmas, considering God coming close to us and linked to the fact we might not have been physically close to those we love this year but we can be close to them in other ways. It's supported by 10 YouTube videos, which share Bible stories, prayers, and demonstrations of how to do craft activities.

The material is suitable for delivery face-to-face in a group, online, or could be sent to parents/carers for them to do with their children at home. Although we think programme content is important, connection with children, young people and their families is even more so. So we'd encourage leaders to tailor these resource tools for their own context and community allowing space for things like dialogue, prayer, outreach, and points of connection in a COVID-19 secure manner. These programme booklets were produced exclusively for Girls' Brigade leaders but we're happy to share them via email for a suggested donation of £5 per PDF.

Intro Outro is a YouTube channel that creates weekly videos designed to positively inspire young people. The channel introduces Gen Z-A to the Christian faith. Every video is different; sometimes funny, sometimes thought provoking, but always accessible for young people. Leading up to Christmas there will be Christmas themed videos all linked to the biblical narrative of Christmas. Use these as part of youth sessions, a Church service online or simply send links directly to young people to watch and then follow up.

Many parents have shared how they don't feel confident to explore faith as a family and when asked young people are not sure how they can connect with God in the home. We want to help families be confident in living out faith in the everyday nooks and crannies of life, especially when so much time is being spent in the home together and access to church and youth groups is limited. These videos, of practical and creative ideas of how faith can be explored at home, can be sent out to young people and families to encourage them to gather within their household this Christmas and have a go together. Christmas in a Box

A fresh way of sharing the Christmas story in what we hope will be a special 'wonder' moment of spiritual development and RE learning for primary school children. The idea is for local churches to facilitate the session/s in school (if possible) as a way of building their relationship with the school and blessing them. This year, it may be more likely that the resource will be delivered to school by the local church for



teachers to facilitate. As you know, some churches are able to host Christmas Experiences in church (in ordinary times) – these are wonderful but people-resource heavy. Christmas in a Box provides a more simple alternative for smaller, less resourced churches. Our hope is that churches will use it with one year group (or two) year on year in their local primary schools.

We also have a pack of downloadable resources and a Source File for ideas of where to purchase the other resources required. If anyone is interested in using Christmas in a Box they can get in touch with us for these files.

We estimate it costs between £170 and £200 to put a box together – but it's an investment as this resource can be used year after year. In addition, it costs between £1.50 and £2 per child for the consumable items.



Jesse Tree

This year the light, hope and peace which Jesus brings is more significant than ever. The winter is dreaded by many, with COVID-19 related restrictions on socialising and contact with others. In this Advent season, a Jesse tree on display in a window or garden at home or outside a church could be a really wonderful symbol of hope.

Now and Then: Reflecting on 2020 through the Christmas story

Five 'scenes' take the context and characters from the Christmas story and invite us to make connections with life during the pandemic.

Perfect for adults and young people - as individuals or in groups

Each scene includes questions, prayer, a song to explore a passage from Luke or Matthew's account of the Christmas story.

Explore the connection between 'now' and 'then' through a monologue where a voice talks about an aspect of life in the pandemic, and then switches to a voice from a character in the Christmas story.
